This encouraging verse can help us during life's often challenging journey.


The May-June edition of the CDS News-Brief (shown on the CDS website, <a href="https://www.christiandental.org">www.christiandental.org</a> under "About Us") gave an example of God's divine providence, and CDS members pulling together against seemingly impossible obstacles, to relocate a 31-person, student, dental/construction mission team from Belize to Jamaica within a week. The CDS promised a follow-up mission report from Sue and Ashley Morabito:

"We had originally planned to serve in Belize, but just one week before departure, we learned our dental application would not be approved, despite submitting everything months in advance. What could have been a roadblock turned into a divine redirection as CDS members introduced us to Dr. Jim Carney. With just days to shift logistics and repack supplies, we rerouted and said 'Yes' to whatever and however God directed.

We arrived in Jamaica with 31 volunteers who provided clinical care, upgraded equipment, poured concrete, built ramps, repaired water lines, and most importantly, poured love into every person we encountered. A small group also led a joyful Vacation Bible School for young children, planting seeds of faith and joy that we pray will continue to grow.

The numbers only tell part of the account. Behind every filling, every construction project, every repaired dental chair—there is a name, a face, and a story. There were patients who had not seen a dentist. Children danced and sang songs about Jesus. Team members stepped outside their comfort zones and left with hearts forever changed. We came to serve—but we were blessed just as deeply in return.

The most exciting annual event that the CDS helps coordinate is the Great Commission Dental Conference (GCDC), that was successfully held for the first time last October. The CDS and CMDA are excited to announce that it will occur again on September 12-13 at the Bent Tree Bible Fellowship Church near Dallas, Texas, located at 4141 International Pkwy, in Carrollton, TX. Numerous members of the CDS will present on various mission topics. This amazing, Christian, dental, mission conference provides an opportunity to connect with Christian-minded dentists, hygienists, students, and others from around the world who are interested in using dentistry as a mission outreach.

The venue site has been changed this year to accommodate an even larger audience than last year. The break-out sessions have increased from 24 to 32, spiritually-inspired, educational, and encouraging topics. The GCDC will have a professional worship leader, missional exhibit booths, fascinating plenary topics, continuing education credit, and great food served on-site.

Last year, CDS members brought in a room full (about \$200,000) of instruments, equipment, supplies, toothbrushes, etc. to donate towards missions, and it was gone on the first day. If you have unused dental items sitting around that you would like to get back into circulation, please bring them to the GCDC. We will again have room to redistribute dental items towards missions.
